From that junction, it is .8 miles back to the Canyon Trail. Total distance of the hike is about 3.1 miles (5.0 kilometers) with about 800 feet of elevation gain.

Volunteers from South Hills Church will return all hikers from Trailhead Park to Bethel Church. The last trip back to Bethel Church will take place at 12:30PM.

# SCIENCE CAMPS



## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CAMPS
